Minutes of the PTA meeting – III (2023-24)

Mrs. Supriya Payare from NMMC (Education Dept.) was present for the meeting.

Agenda:

- 1) Fee hike from the Academic Session 2024-25
- 2) To continue with Development Fees for next five years upto 2029
- 3) To introduce Digital Literacy Fees.

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- Meeting started with Gayatri Mantra
 - Meeting was initiated with welcoming the PTA members by the Secretary
 - Minutes of the meeting – II (dated – 05/08/2023) was read out
 - Display of glimpses of activities conducted in September/ October – 2023
 - Chairperson explained the importance of parent-teacher collaboration.
 - Chairperson presented PPT explained the importance of developing 21st century skills and the school moving towards Digital Literacy as per NEP 2020.
 - The Fee hike was proposed and approved by PTA.

Following were proposed for the school development:

- Robotics lab; Atal Tinkering lab; Language lab; 3D theatre; Financial Literacy Lab, LED in a phased manner.
- Infrastructural Development – Starting with external repairs, painting, etc
- Smart board replacement with LEDs in phased manner
- Fee structure for Academic session 2024-25
- Development fund to be continued for -5 more years
- Digital literacy – 250/- month
- PTA membership – Rs. 50/-
- Insurance for student safety – Rs.100/-
- Mrs. Supriya Payare from NMMC Education Dept. attended the PTA meeting & appreciated the healthy discussion and environment.

Parent's suggestions and solutions provided by the Chairperson:

1. Ashwini Bhole parent of requested for detailed information regarding insurance fee, Robotics lab & financial Literacy

PTA was informed that document regarding group insurance is given.

Robotics and Financial Literacy will be introduced in the next academic session to each and every child.

2. Bindu Yadav & Anand Yadav had a query about Robotics and Financial Literacy
Mr. Rajendra Desai appreciated the initiative taken by School to introduce AI & Computer Literacy.

PTA members were informed that it is necessary to develop 21st century skills. Robotics and language labs will be conducted in zero period. The assessment for these additional subjects shall only be graded.

3. Manjushree Kadam inquired about language labs and also requested to introduce French and German and also requested for more skill subjects.
Painting, pottery, Gandharva Mahavidyalaya, craft, sewing, cooking etc. should be introduced to children.
Trupti Jamboti requested for Sanskrit lab.
During vacations, summer camps should be organized, class teacher should talk about peer pressure.
Rajendra Desai requested for organizing meditation for children.
Anand Yadav suggested to encourage students to talk on current affairs.

PTA was informed that French and German may be planned later. Language labs will be helpful in developing communication skills in English, Hindi, Marathi and Sanskrit.
Zero period activities – meditation, talk on current affairs, peer pressure will be planned.

4. Ashwini Bhole and Trupti Jamboti requested for safety drills and mock drills for evacuation plan.
PTA was informed that evacuation plan floor wise is already displayed on floors and after Diwali mock drills will be carried out.
5. Ashwini Bhole suggested career counselling session from Std-VIII onwards and Bindu Yadav suggested parents as counselors for the session.
Suman Giri requested to motivate and guide children by inviting Alumni to talk to them.

PTA was informed that career counselling is already done for Std – X and parents from different streams and fields will be invited for counselling children for other classes.
Alumni talk for higher classes is already done and will be planned for other classes also.

6. Manjushree Kadam enquired about fee structure for special cases and relaxation in specific fee amount.
Bindu Yadav also enquired about RTE fee payment
Ashwini Bhole, Sudam Ingle & Suman Giri requested for permission for extension for fee payment.

PTA were informed that some parents and teachers are helping in payment of fees for students who are from financially weaker sections.
Parents may come and speak to the Principal regarding it.

7. Ashwini Bhole enquired about Picnic arrangements.

PTA was informed that visit to NDA will be planned.
AC buses will be arranged for picnics.

8. Bindu Yadav and Manjushree Kadam requested for Annual Function every year and all parents to be invited, farewell for Std – X.

PTA was informed that in January DAV United Function is planned and Annual Sports will be planned. As school is till Std – XII, so farewell is planned only for Std- XII.
