The Mauryan administration was run under the guidance of Chanakya. The King was the Head of the State and enjoyed supreme powers of military, judiciary and civil administration. He had a Mantri Parishad (Council of Ministers) to advise and assist him. However, the king was not bound to follow their advice. The ministers were appointed on the basis of merit. He kept ladies as his body- guards. Amatya, Mahamatra Adhyaksha, Purohita, Senapati, Yuvraj were some of the officials in his court. There was a very efficient espionage system. The whole empire was divided into smaller units for efficient administration. The city administration was under Nagradhyaksh or Nagrik (like mayor). He was helped by 30 members. They were divided into six boards of five members each. Each board was assigned different duties to be performed. The village administration was run by a group of officers. They kept records of the people, collected taxes and maintained law and order in their village.
