



ZERO TOLERANCE TOWARDS BULLYING

Dear Parents and Students,

In alignment with the directives of the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), our school remains committed to providing a safe, warm, and welcoming environment for every child. Bullying is a serious matter that can affect a student's emotional and academic well-being. We maintain a Zero Tolerance Policy toward any form of bullying.

1. What Counts as Bullying?

Bullying is any repeated, intentional behavior meant to hurt or scare someone. This includes:

- Physical: Hitting, pushing, or damaging someone's things.
- Verbal: Name-calling, insults, or threatening someone.
- Social: Spreading rumours or leaving someone out on purpose.
- Cyber: Sending hurtful messages or photos via social media or mobile phones.

2. Our Reporting Mechanism (As per CBSE Guidelines)

If a student feels they are being bullied, or if a parent suspects their child is being targeted, please follow these steps:

- Immediate Reporting: Inform the Class Teacher or the School Counselor/ Principal immediately. You can do this in person or via a written note.
- Anti-Bullying Committee: The case will be referred to our School's Internal
- Confidentiality: Every report is handled with the utmost privacy to protect the student who is reporting.
- Inquiry: The committee will speak to all parties involved separately to understand the situation clearly.

3. Consequences and Support

As per CBSE regulations, the school will take appropriate action which may include counseling for both the victim and the bully, parental meetings, or disciplinary measures as defined in the school handbook. Our primary goal is to reform and safety.

4. How Parents Can Help

- Listen to your child without judgment if they share a concern.
- Encourage your child to be an "Upstander" (someone who speaks up) rather than a "Bystander."
- Monitor your child's online activity to prevent cyber-bullying.
- Let us work together to make our school a "Bully-Free Zone" where every student feels respected and valued
