THE CLEVER CAP-SELLER

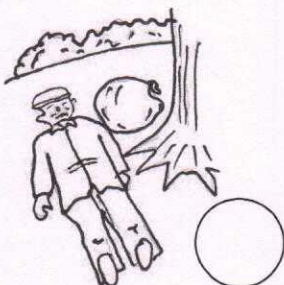
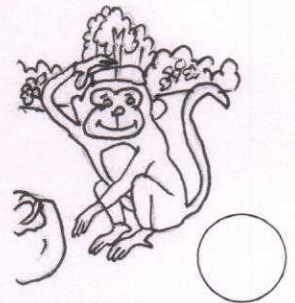

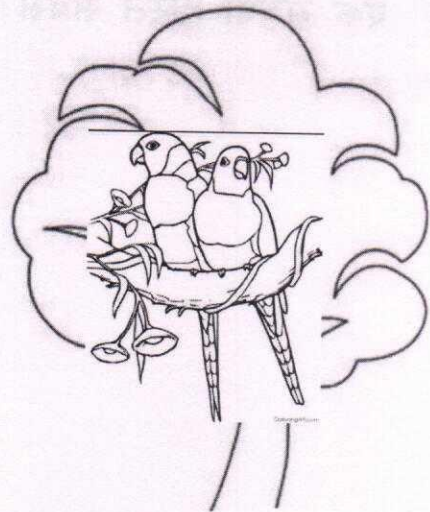
