- DAV Public School, Airoli has been awarded as the “Best School” in 7th International Abacus Vedic & Mental Maths Olympiad 2021-22.

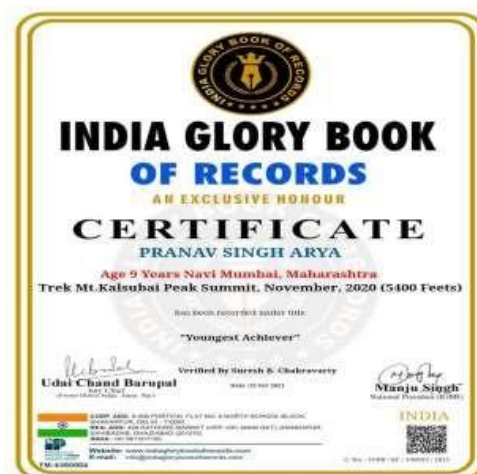


SPORTS ACHIEVEMENTS

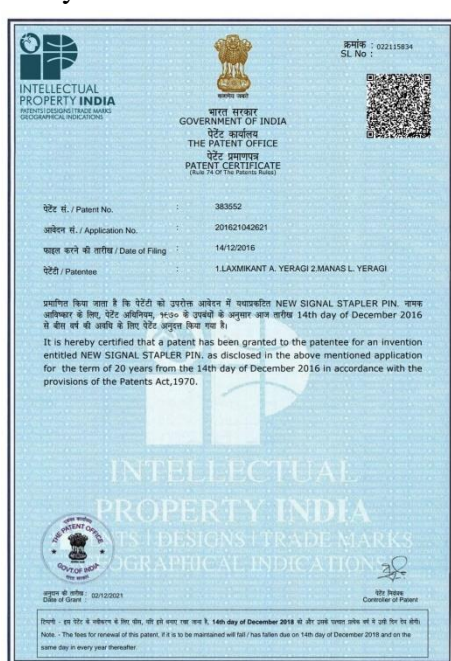
